Letter issued to the B.D.O Development Officer, Block the Accordingly, 25.11.2014 Patharpratima, Patharpratima, South 24 Parganas is directed to South 24 Parganas carefully enquire and ascertain as to whether they are otherwise eligible to get benefit out of the renamed vide Memo No. 2057/ZP/Law/14 scheme "Geetanjali". dated 25.11.2014 District Magistrate & **Executive Officer** South 24 Parganas Zilla Parishad Received enquiry report from Block Development 3 Officer, Patharpratima, South 24 Parganas vide Memo 04.12.2014 No. 1857/BDO dated 4.12.2014. This report clearly states that 39 petitioners' houses were partly damaged by AILA and they have already been granted compensation from AILA Relief Fund, and remaining petitioners' houses were not damaged by AILA. Perused the enquiry report along with photographs of the petitioners' houses and considering all other aspects of the petitioners' and as per the solemn order dated 05.09.2014 passed by the Hon'ble Justice N. Patherya, it is found that 4 petitioners ware not affected by AILA and 39 petitioners have already been granted compensation from the AILA Relief Fund. In the view of the above facts and circumstances, relief prayed by the petitioners cannot be considered as they are not eligible.
