





Received enquiry report from B.D.O., Mathurapur - I, South 24 Parganas, vide Memo No. 1375 dated 11.11.2014 this enquiry report is as follows :

1. At the time of field enquiry we have recorded the statements of neighbours of the petitioners and taken photographs of the petitioners' houses. As per the statement of the neighbours some of the houses were damaged by AILA, and some others were repaired or renovated partly or fully during last 3-4 years after AILA.
2. It was also found that only two of the petitioners were duly granted compensation from the AILA relief Fund.
3. During the field enquiry we could not trace 10 nos. of petitioners house at the specifically mentioned location/address and there are 5 nos. of petitioners who do not belong to the economically weaker section of the society as per guideline.



According to report it is clearly stated that the petitioners being namely Bapi Halder, son of - Late Bhusan Halder, Bimal Halder, son of - Adhir Halder, Uttam Halder, son of - Late Sadhan Halder, Serina Bibi Halder, wife of - Sajahan Halder, Kishori Halder son of Late Nilkanta Halder, Jahural Khan son of Inomuch Khan, Jiarul Sekh son of Late Golam Bari Sekh, Biswajit Halder son of Nitya Nanda Halder, Rejaul Sekh son of Late Golam Bari, Bimal Gayen son of Sadhan Gayen, Amal Gayen son of Rabindranath

Mondal, Madhusudan Halder son of Kartick Halder could not be traced out at the specifically mentioned address and 5 nos. of petitioners being namely Gopal Halder son of Jagai Halder, Jayanth Naiya son of Chittaranjan Naiya, Mahadeb Naiya son of Arjun Naiya, Ananta Halder son of Basari Halder, Balai Ruhidas son of Badal Ruhidas do not belong to the economically weaker section of the society as per the prevailing guideline and remaining petitioners' houses were damaged by AILA, partly or fully, among them some petitioners have repaired or renovated their damaged houses partly or fully and they are affected by AILA being they belong to the

economically weaker section of the local society of that region.

Perused the enquiry report along with photographs of the petitioners' house and considering the statements of neighbors' and other aspects of the petitioners and as per the solemn order dated 14.05.2014 passed by the Hon'ble Justice Dipankar Dutta, the Sundarban Affairs Department is to consider the petitioners who are affected by AILA for receiving benefit of the GEETANJALI scheme as early as possible.
